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## CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES 2018

Dear Parents & Guardians

Financial support provided by parents & guardians has always played an enabling role in the provision of resources that extend the school's capacity to add value to students' learning experiences.

Therefore, in accordance with *the School Education Act 1999*, the *School Education Regulations 2000* and the *Contributions, Charges and Fees manual*, the following contributions and charges for 2018 have been approved by the South Perth Primary School Board.

### **1. VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION**

South Perth Primary School has an approved **voluntary contribution of \$60 per student**. As the name states, the contribution is voluntary but payment of the \$60 (or part thereof) assists with the provision of:

- Photocopied materials for all learning areas
- Library Resource Centre collection purchases
- PE resources
- Maths resources
- Science resources
- Humanities and Social Sciences resources
- Art/Craft resources
- Digital Technology resources
- Music resources

Your contribution towards these costs is greatly appreciated and parents are encouraged to pay their school voluntary contributions at the beginning of the school year. If this arrangement is not possible then parents can pay in installments or discuss alternative payment options with the Manager Corporate Services.

### **2. VOLUNTARY APPROVED REQUEST - P&C ASSOCIATION**

The P&C is a major contributor to the school's physical, social and educational environment. This significant support is made possible by voluntary contributions, fundraising events and the volunteering of time and expertise. In 2018, the P&C have agreed to fund:

- A school licence for 'Mathletics' and 'Reading Eggs'.
- Additional time for the School Chaplain.
- Additional 'Nature Play' areas.

The Voluntary Approved Request - P&C Association for all Kindergarten to Year Six students in 2016 is **\$125 for families with one child and \$150 for families with two or more children**.

Payment of this amount is voluntary and can be made in conjunction with payments for voluntary contributions and upfront extra cost optional items.

### 3. EXTRA COST OPTIONAL ITEMS

Items in this category indicate estimated costs that parents may incur when students participate in activities that are designed to reinforce the core educational program.

The following table identifies the **maximum** possible extra costs for each year group.

**Actual costs may be less** than those indicated and students will only incur costs when they are involved in the particular activity. Certain sections are left blank as some costs do not apply to all year groups.

It is extremely important to remember that the following predicted costs are for optional activities. The decision to participate in these activities is at the discretion of the parents.

If a student does not participate in a particular activity, they will be provided with an alternative course, or activity, that allows the student to achieve similar educational outcomes.
